Application Requirements

All students must submit a completed application packet by the given deadline. Within the application packets, students must include all of the following:

- A completed Internship Application (available on-line)
- College transcripts (unofficial transcripts may be accepted for initial consideration)
- A recommendation letter from a faculty member or past employer
- A professional resume
