RE-SETTING OF AD VALOREM TAX MILLAGE FOR 1979.


Chairman Wooten announced that a special meeting was being called for the purpose of resetting ad valorem tax millage for the current year as required by the State Revenue Commissioner in order to correspond revenue proceeds with the pre-factored tax digest.

Motion was made by Commissioner Curry and seconded by Commissioner Dusenbury to re-set ad valorem tax millage for 1979 as follows:

<u>District 1</u> ; County Wide (Unincorporated areas of County, excluding Brunswick and Jekyll Island)	6.60 mills
<u>District 2</u> ; Sterling, Blythe Island, Ballard	3.03 mills
<u>District 2-B</u> ; St. Simons, Sea Island	2.65 mills
<u>District 2-C</u> ; Sea Island Police	1.60 mills
<u>District 2-D</u> ; Brunswick and Jekyll Island	4.04 mills
