

CALLED MEETING, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, GLYNN  
COUNTY, GEORGIA, HELD AUGUST  
22, 1978 at 7:00 P.M.

Adoption of Pay Schedule for Employees.

A pay increase of \$ .42 per hour per employee was recommended to the Board by Administrator Perkins. He noted that this increase was in the best interest of the lower paid employees at the entry level positions, and would especially benefit Firemen and Leisure Service Employees. The total cost of this increase for the current year would be 1.3 mills or approximately \$440,000, he said, and the percentage increase for entry level would be approximately 16%.

Motion was made by Commissioner Dixon and seconded by Commissioner Dusenbury to approve this pay increase and authorize its immediate implementation.

Commissioner Owens made a motion to make this pay increase effective July 1, 1978, and Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion. Commissioner Smith offered an amendment to limit the increase to those presently employed by the County and Commissioner Dixon seconded the amendment. The amended motion was then unanimously adopted.

Adoption of St. Simons Island Water & Sewer Budget for Calendar Year 1978.

Motion was made by Commissioner Dixon to approve 1978 Budget for the St. Simons Island Water & Sewer District. Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Adoption of 1978 Budget for The Brunswick-St. Simons (F.J. Torras) Causeway.

Motion was made by Commissioner Dixon to approve 1978 Budget for the Brunswick-St. Simons (F.J. Torras) Causeway. Commissioner Curry seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Five Year Plan for Malcolm McKinnon Airport.

Aviation Director Bill Dewey presented an Integrated Airport Implementation Program for the Commission's review. He stressed the need for immediate improvements that should be made immediately at McKinnon Airport. He also discussed the probability of obtaining federal funds to help finance these improvements.

Chairman Boyd suggested that the improvement cost list submitted by Mr. Dewey be added to the budget for McKinnon Airport and discussed at a later meeting.

Mr. Dewey asked permission of the Commission to go to Atlanta to look into a federal grant for these needed improvements. Commissioner Curry made a motion authorizing Mr. Dewey's trip to Atlanta for this purpose. Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Easter Seal Auction.


Lee Silver, Director of Leisure Services, came before the Commission to present request from the Easter Seal Association that they be allowed to hold an auction during the Island Arts Festival. After a brief discussion, it was agreed to allow this auction to be held on the St. Simons Pier, subject to Mr. Silver's approval. The decision was put into motion by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Dusenbury.

Adopted by majority vote with one dissent by Commissioner Curry.


