

Commissioner Boyd moved to adopt a position letter to the City of Brunswick requesting that City and County engineering firms ask for an extension of the February deadline for submitting revised applications to the Environmental Protection Division, Department of Natural Resources covering grants for the North Glynn County Sewerage project, Phase A, and the position be stated in this letter to the City that the County, having already budgeted for this project for fiscal year 1974-75, is not financially able to use funds from the General Fund for this purpose; however, it is the desire of County Government to assist the City in acquiring the necessary extensions, realizing this project to be a basic need in gaining industrial and residential growth in prescribed areas; also, the County is interested in discussing with the City the possibility of combining all water and sewer functions throughout the City and County under one unit of control whether it be on a basis of a mutually formed Joint City/Commission or Authority, depending on which would be the most logical choice of operation.

Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.
