JULY 31, 1975

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Percy F. Harrell, Commissioners Roy Boyd, Robert Owens, Henry Smith and Vice Chairman Lorraine Dusenbury

The meeting was called to official order by Chairman Percy F. Harrell.

Motion was made by Commissioner Robert Owens, seconded by Commissioner Henry T. Smith and unanimously adopted to approve Contract No. PR-204(3), Glynn County, from the Department of Transportation, State of Georgia, covering grubbing, grading and draining of 3.551 miles of roadway on the Pennick Road, at an estimated cost of \$75,838.

Motion was made by Commissioner Roy Boyd to adopt the following resolution. Commissioner Robert Owens seconded the motion.

WHEREAS, Brunswick Harbor has revitalized the industrial growth and stimulated the economic development of Glynn County and the State of Georgia, and

WHEREAS, the Glynn County Board of Commissioners has evaluated all factors of the proposed plan for deepening of the existing Brunswick Harbor and the dredging of a new channel to Colonels Island, and

WHEREAS, the tributary area served by the Port of Brunswick consists of 14 counties, and there are approximately 55 industrial enterprises in Glynn County alone which are port-related, and

WHEREAS, the present channel depths are inadequate for handling modern vessels and modification would permit larger vessels, reduce shipping cost, increase navigation safety into and through the harbor, as well as attract additional commerce, and

WHEREAS, the proposed navigation improvements would produce additional employment, increased property values, development of new industry and improvement of the local economy and that of the State of Georgia.

THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, Glynn County, Georgia, that this project receive the full support and cooperation of Glynn County to insure the success of this plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT by this action taken, the County of Glynn does recognize Brunswick Harbor as one of the most important entities in this section of the State of Georgia.
