CALLED MEETING, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,
GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA, HELD FRIDAY,
FEBRUARY 2, 1973 AT 11:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Chairman John E. Taylor, Commissioners Roy J. Boyd, Lorraine Dusenbury,
Percy F. Harrell and R.E. Owens.

The Meeting opened with invocation by Commissioner Owens.

W.G. Thigpen, Jr., complained that the County has a ditch across his property adjacent to Highway 17 across from Howard Johnson's Motel. Mr. Thigpen requested that the ditch be filled in, stating that the ditch is not needed in the area and the County holds no easement on it. He further agreed with the Commissioners to assume full responsibility for any and all future drainage problems whatever they might be arising from filling in the ditch.

County Engineer Don McCaskill and Public Works Superintendent Earl Davis cited need for maintaining the ditch, stating that it had been formed when marshland was filled in on either side.

Commissioner Boyd made a motion that based on Mr. Thigpen's agreement (as stated above) the County let Mr. Thigpen exercise his own judgement in blocking this natural drainage, and the County will have nothing further to do with it. Commissioner Harrell seconded the motion.

Unanimously adopted.

Mr. Davis was instructed to fill the ditch back in where it has been cleared out.

Motion was made by Commissioner Boyd, seconded by Commissioner Harrell, to adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS, there is presently pending before the General Assembly of the State of Georgia a bill amending compensation being paid to the Sheriff of Glynn County, Georgia, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Glynn County, Georgia have not had ample opportunity to consider this legislation and the effects thereof, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire that the compensation of all constitutional officers of Glynn County be adjusted to reflect a fair and adequate compensation for the duties and responsibilities of said officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Glynn County, Georgia desire that the present bill pending before the General Assembly of Georgia be withdrawn so that no change will result in compensation of the Sheriff of Glynn County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the Board of Commissioners of Glynn County, Georgia to evidence their desire as above stated and a copy delivered to the Honorable Eston Harden and the Honorable Charles W. Rogers, representatives to the General Assembly from Glynn County for appropriate action, and the Honorable Roscoe E. Dean and Honorable Edward Zipper, Senators, for their support.

Aye: Commissioners Boyd, Dusenbury and Harrell.


Nay: Commissioner Owens.

Motion passed.


Commissioner Owens moved that the Commission meet with local representatives to the General Assembly to discuss legislation referred to in the above stated resolution.
