

PRESENT: Chairman John E. Taylor, Commissioners Roy J. Boyd, Lorraine Dusenbury, Percy F. Harrell and R. E. Owens.

The meeting opened with invocation by Commissioner Owens.

Dr. P. S. Kwaitowski, Director of the Glynn County Board of Health, and Foye O. Stacey, District Chief of Administration, East Health District, Georgia Department of Human Resources, reported that recently proposed House Bill 360 will drastically reduce appropriation to the Board of Health and Department of Family and Children Services which will be combined under the Department of Human Resources.

Commissioner Owens moved that local legislators be requested to do whatever possible to have the previously proposed \$21 million reinstated in this program. Commissioner Harrell seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted

James M. Richardson, County Tax Appraiser, reported that valuation on several parcels of land and buildings owned by Sea Island Company and Sea Island Properties have been arbitrated and drastically reduced. The Board of Tax Assessors have subsequently recommended that these arbitrations be appealed to the Superior Court of Glynn County.

Commissioner Owen's motion to proceed with appeal of said cases died for lack of second.

After further discussion, Commissioner Boyd moved to appeal these arbitrations and Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion.

Unanimously adopted.

Commissioner Boyd moved to establish a policy of basically following the Board of Tax Assessors recommendation on all cases that go through the Board of Equalization. Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Motion was made by Commissioner Boyd seconded by Commissioner Owens, to proceed with contract with the H. L. Yoh Company for re-appraisal of all taxable properties in Glynn County. Commissioner Owens seconded the motion.

Aye: Commissioners Boyd, Dusenbury and Owens.

Nay: Commissioner Harrell and Chairman Taylor.

Motion passed.

Attorney Bishop reported that he was not familiar with the above referenced contract, however, it has been reviewed by Attorney Whelchel.

J. H. Blackerby requested that building permits be issued to property owners in Basswood Estate even though streets have not been accepted by the County.

Commissioner Owens moved to defer action until the next regular meeting to allow each Commissioner an opportunity to investigate the roads in question. Commissioner Boyd seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Commissioner Boyd moved to grant two building permits in Basswood Estates as property owners have already located mobile homes in the area and are unable to obtain utilities. (Lee and Starland).


Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Upon request of Wheldon Stamps, representing Jekyll T. V. Cable, Inc. for permit to utilize County Rights of Way to provide Cable TV Service to small outlying areas in the County. Commissioner Boyd moved to authorize drafting of such agreement by Attorneys. Commissioner Dusenbury seconded the motion and it was unanimously adopted.
