CALLED MEETING, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,  
GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA, HELD  
TUESDAY, JUNE 26 AT 9:00 am  
1973

PRESENT: Chairman Jone E. Taylor, Commissioners Roy J. Boyd, Lorraine Dusenbury, Percy F. Harrell and Robert E. Owens.

Also Present: Administrator Harold H. Baer, Attorneys James A. Bishop and J. Thomas Whelchel, Architects Joseph Schlosser and Larry Miller.

Joseph L. Schlosser and Larry Miller, architects for the proposed new Glynn County Detention Center, reported that Attorney Tom Whelchel has concurred that proposal and bid bond of low bidders on the project, A.J. Kellos Construction Company and Willo Products, are in order.

Motion was made by Commissioner Boyd, seconded by Commissioner Harrell, to award bid for construction of the Glynn County Detention Center to A.J. Kellos Construction Company in the amount of \$1,043,000.00.

Unanimously adopted.

Motion was made by Commissioner Owens, seconded by Commissioner Dusenbury to award bid to Willo Products for furnishing and installing jail equipment for the Glynn County Detention Center in the amount of \$243,000.00.

Unanimously adopted.

Attorney James A. Bishop reported that one parcel of land located adjacent to the present jail which has been acquired by the County still has a house on it. As the owners of the house plan to move it, he asked what date the contractor would need the site.

Chairman Taylor directed Attorney Bishop to give owners of the house a notice to have it removed by July 10.

Administrator Baer announced that a pre-construction conference with the contractor has been scheduled for Monday at 2:00 p.m., and bids for construction of a Temporary Detention Center will be opened Thursday, June 26.

Motion was made by Commissioner Boyd, seconded by Commissioner Dusenbury, to authorize retention of Mr. Bernard Carmichael of Montgomery, Alabama as the County's Master Appraiser Institute Member for the purpose of establishing the settlement method of the ad valorem taxes and the valuation thereof, in the case of Glynn County vs. Sea Island Company and Sea Island Properties, Inc.

Unanimously adopted.



Motion for approval was made by Commissioner Harrell and seconded by Commissioner Boyd, with the stipulation that permit will be revoked in the event of excessive littering.


Unanimously adopted.
