Dusenbury to approve 1973 Budget as set up for Revenue Sharing Funds.


Unanimously adopted.


Attorney Bishop announced that while in Atlanta last week he contacted  
John Mobley, Bond Attorney with the Firm of Gambrell and Mobley, and Lex Jolley,  
President of Lex Jolley & Co., Inc. Municipal and Corporate Securities, regarding  
financing a proposed second causeway. He said that both were of the opinion that bonds  
would not be marketable if based on a study conducted by the Department of Transportation.  
He added that discussion with Downing Musgrove revealed that the state is unable to make  
a feasibility study but will offer any assistance requested by any engineering firm employed  
by the County.
