

CALLLED MEETING, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, GLYNN
COUNTY, GEORGIA, HELD THURSDAY, SEPT.
27, 1973 AT 5:00 P.M.

PRESENT: Chairman John E. Taylor, Commissioners Roy J. Boyd, Lorraine
Dusenbury, Percy F. Harrell and Robert E. Owens.

Also Present: Administrator Harold H. Baer and Attorney James A. Bishop.

After a brief discussion of the purchase of radio equipment for the
Sheriff's Department, Chairman Taylor suggested the bid be given to Herman Lang,
and the Commission approved such action.

Administrator Baer presented a letter from Cecil Little, Supervisor of
Elections, requesting purchase of five voting machines. In this correspondence Mr.
Little related that the firm selling the machines would be willing to reserve five
additional machines for the County for one year at the current cost.

Approval was expressed for purchase of five machines now with a contract
to purchase five more next year.


Motion was made by Commissioner Boyd and seconded by Commissioner
