GEORGIA, HELD AUGUST 21, 1971 AT 5:00 P. M.

A long discussion was held on the County providing ambulance service. A visit by the Governor to Glynn County on this date indicated that the State had approved the grant and that certain funds would be furnished to the County in support of this program.


A motion was made by Commissioner Taylor, seconded by Commissioner Owens, to meet the September 1st deadline with regard to furnishing this service to residents of the County and that four (4) ambulances which meet the established criteria be purchased from Crain Garage M-M Sales, Inc. of Marietta, Georgia. All Commissioners present, including the Chairman, voted aye on this motion and it was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Harold Box discussed the purchase of ambulances and indicated that he had contacted Coastal Chevrolet and it was his understanding that they could not make the September 1st deadline.
