2013 Property Assessment Notices to be Mailed

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- Glynn County's Chief Appraiser, Ron Glisson, has announced that 2013 Property Assessment Notices will be mailed to over 48,000 Property Owners on Friday, May 10, 2013.

"I am very pleased with the accuracy of this year's values" said Glisson. "The State Law we work to requires us to value all property at 'Fair Market Value' and with 'Uniformity', both within and between our neighborhoods. Our internal tests show we have been very successful in adhering to these concepts."

Property owners have 45 calendar days from the postmark date to appeal their assessment, which they may do by either meeting with members of the Property Appraisal staff in person or by regular mail. There is an appeal form on the County's website for the convenience of those who wish to file by mail.

Each assessment notice contains the name of the person in the Property Appraisal Office who is most familiar with the property. Property owners should first contact that person if they have any questions.
