

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE HELD TUESDAY APRIL 9TH., 1940.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott to approve all disbursements for the period March 6, 1940 to April 2nd., 1940, inclusive, in the total amount of \$42,689.71 covered by Vouchers #55755 to #55911 inclusive. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Ratcliffe, Seconded by Commissioner Harley to purchase \$25,000.00 - 6 months time certificate from the Brunswick Bank and Trust Company. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe to approve additional collateral, deposited by the Brunswick Bank and Trust Company because of increased County deposits; said collateral consisting of Safe Keeping Receipt of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta #22662 covering \$50,000.00 par value State of Georgia 2% Highway Refunding Bonds due March 15th., 1947; said collateral being placed with all other collateral in Safe Deposit Box No. GC-24. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe to approve "List of Errors and Defaulters Relieved" consisting of two sheets dated Dec. 31, 1939 in total sum of \$1852.79. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, unanimously adopted, to approve following application of the Timber Protective Organization for constructing pole line on old G.C.&P. Right of Way:

March 1, 1940.

"Commissioners Roads and Revenue,
Glynn County, Georgia.

Gentlemen:-

The undersigned desire to construct a telephone line on the old G.C. & P. Right of Way to the junction with the old Jesup Road in line with the attached sketch.

The undersigned agrees to do the work under the supervision of the County Engineer and subject to his approval.

The pole line will be located a sufficient distance from the roadway so that there will be no interference with the highway maintenance operations and no danger to traffic.

Cutting of timber will be held to a minimum. Where it is necessary to trim or prune trees the work will be done in a workmanlike manner and all stumps, brush and debris removed.

In the event that it is necessary to widen the roadbed or right of way, the undersigned agrees to move the pole line back to such location on the right of way as designated by the County.

Application on the basis of the above conditions is respectfully submitted for the construction of this pole line.
