Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Royal, to approve all disbursements for the period September 6th., to October 3rd., 1940, inclusive, in the total amount of \$24,959.69, covered by Vouchers #56790-56978 inclusive. Unanimously adopted.

Mr. McFerrin representing the St. Simons Star appeared requesting the amount of \$22.00 be paid for the publication of 1940 County Audit.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott to pay St. Simons Star \$22.00 for publication of 1940 Audit and, in the future that publications of Audits be confined to the Official County Organ.

Mrs. R. S. Ledsinger appeared and requested that Tax Assessors grant hearing on her 1940 taxes. Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Owens to ask Tax Assessors to re-open case and hear Mrs. Ledsinger. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Royal, to have Superintendent Higginbotham investigate road at S. M. Tison's place. Unanimously adopted.

C. A. Tarte appeared and requested that County repair road leading from public road to his place, same being referred to Mr. Higginbotham to handle. Unanimously adopted.

Letter received from J. M. Exley, Tax Commissioner requesting Board to pass resolution on 1938 Term as being approved by the Commission. Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to refer same to County Attorney for handling. Unanimously adopted.

Letter was received from Parker Realty Company making an offer of \$200.00 for Urbana Lots #251 and #252 owned by County. Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Owens to notify Mr. Kaufman, Agent, that the least County would accept would be \$400.00. Unanimously adopted.

A letter from D. W. Middleton, Jr., was received representing Dixie Investment Company, 1940 Taxes. Taxes on above property being raised without his being notified. Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Owens to ask Tax Assessors to re-open case and hear Mr. Middleton. Unanimously adopted.
