

CALLED MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, HELD TUESDAY, OCTOBER 22ND., 1940.

Present:- R. A. Gould, C. V. Abbott, V. H. Royal, R. L. Ratcliffe, W. McD. Harley and J. B. D. Paulk.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

No persons having appeared before the Commission at the regular meeting held Tuesday, October 8th., in connection with public hearing for classifying the Pine View Subdivision as Class "B" Residential District, it was moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Abbott that the zoning of Pine View Subdivision as Class "B" Residential District be finally adopted. Unanimously adopted.

The following Resolution offered by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe was unanimously adopted:-

WHEREAS, J. M. Exley, the Tax Commissioner of Glynn County, has duly submitted his reports as such Tax Commissioner for the years 1938 and 1939 and the same have been examined by the County Auditor; therefore ---

Be it resolved by the Commissioners of Roads and Revenue of Glynn County, that the said reports be accepted and filed as being correct in all respects so far as now appears to the said Board of Commissioners.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Owens to compensate Mr. L. S. Miller, architect, in the amount of \$600.00 covering the County's half of the preparation of Plans for the Armory, the City of Brunswick to take care of the other half; it being the understanding that the total architectural fees of L. S. Miller in connection with this project are not to exceed \$1500.00 in line with his letter of October 22nd., 1940. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott that the Engineer-Director be directed to secure estimate of cost of groin construction and feasibility of such construction, based on Plan A of the Report of the Beach Erosion Board for Erosion Control on St. Simons Island. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, seconded by Commissioner Abbott to authorize publication of Report Covering the County's Activities for the Fiscal Year 1940. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Harley to advise the Dixie Mirror Inc., Savannah, Georgia, that it is against the policy of Glynn County to place advertising, other than legal notices, in any publication and that no Ad can be taken in the Dixie Mirror. Unanimously adopted.
