

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING COMMISSIONERS ROADS AND REVENUE HELD THURSDAY, DECEMBER 5, 1940.

Present:- R. A. Gould, J. L. Owens, R. L. Ratcliffe, J. B. D. Paulk, C. V. Abbott, V. H. Royal and W. McD. Harley.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

The following reports were approved and ordered filed:-

St. Simons Highway.
City Hospital.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to approve all disbursements for the period November 7th to December 5th, 1940, inclusive, in the total amount of \$30,492.23, covered by Vouchers #57140-57317, inclusive. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to approve the Plat of the Hopkins Estate Subdivision. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to approve the Plat of the Community Subdivision. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to accept the low bid of S. Herndon & Sons in the amount of \$2,348.00 for painting the interior and fixtures of the Court House. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to authorize the Chairman and Engineer-Director to employ necessary help to analyze the County Tax Deeds in order to secure maximum returns from the property involved. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to authorize charging off the 1933, 1934 and 1935 taxes covering the stock of goods of the Estate N. R. Barnhill, which stock is no longer in existence, provided that settlement is made on the remainder of the taxes due, with interest. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to authorize acceptance of \$75.00 in payment of back taxes and interest for the years 1932, 1934 and 1935 on the property of D. C. Cowart in Block 43 of the Day Tract on Norwich Street, in line with letter of November 13, 1940 from J. J. Lissner, Jr. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Royal, to exempt from 1940 and future County taxation the property of Camp Reese, Camp Marion and the H. Street Building of the Kiwanis Club for Under-Privileged Boys. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to authorize adjustment of the 1940 taxes of the R. T. Crane Estate on Jekyll Island on the basis of the proposed 1941 assessments to be placed by the board of Tax Assessors which their Chairman, Mr. John Cason, advises will be \$3,000.00; and to authorize adjustment of the 1940 taxes of the Frank M. Gould property, also on Jekyll Island, on the same basis which Mr. Cason advises will be \$3,000.00 for 1941, provided demolition is stopped and roof restored. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Harley, to appropriate \$25.00 to the Red Cross toward their program. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to authorize payment of reward of \$ 500.00 in connection with the conviction of the murderer of Rev. Charles H. Lee at such time as the Solicitor indicates that the case has been closed and reward is payable; an intervention is then to be filed in the Superior Court of Glynn County so that proper determination can be made of the payment of said reward to the different claimants. Unanimously adopted. ✓

Moved by Commissioner Paulk, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to appoint, as Processioners in the 1356th Militia District, Messrs. R. M. Brown and L. A. Savage to replace Messrs. E. L. Smith and B. W. Murray, who resigned November 27, 1940. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to accept the proposal of H. H. Burnet & Company, Waycross, Georgia, for making the Glynn County audit for the two six months periods ending December 31, 1940 and June 30, 1941 respectively, the total cost not to exceed \$900.00. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to authorize payment of 50% of the cost of a dinner to the Glynn County men in military service who are on leave in Brunswick during the Christmas Holidays, with the understanding that the City of Brunswick will pay the remaining half of the cost of the dinner. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to revise Section 3 of the Ordinance regulating Bagatelle Tables in Glynn County as follows:-

SECTION 3 REVISED

An annual license fee of \$10.00 shall be levied for each and every machine operated, on proper application by a duly licensed operator of an amusement place. Such licenses may be transferred from one table to another when and as replacements and repairs are made, provided no transfer of license will be permitted from one location to another location. Charge for licenses, in every case, shall be made for the full year. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to request the American Legion to dedicate the Flag Pole recently installed at the County Casino on St. Simons Island. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Harley, to express approval of the proposed change in legislation passed at the last session of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY permitting tax collectors throughout the State to receive as additional compensation of 10% commission on all taxes collected over and above 90% of the tax digest; the proposed change being for the purpose of eliminating such additional compensation. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to approve the proposal of the Board of Commissioners of Bibb County regarding enactment of legislation for fixing license fees for various types of businesses located outside the corporate limits of Municipalities. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to authorize execution of Quit Claim Deed to Lot #86 Windsor Park to John L. Nowell in view of loss of original Deed to Secure Debt together with cancellation, said indebtedness having been paid in full February 7, 1939. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to authorize advertisement of sale of Urbana Lots 251 and 252 based on offer of A. R. Fain in the amount of \$325.00 for such lots. Unanimously adopted.
