The Chairman stated that the purpose of the Joint Meeting was to discuss a request from Citizens that a yearly permit be sold on the St.Simons Highway.

And, Also a request from Sea Island Company that Children living in Brunswick and attending the Plunkett School on Sea Island should be granted free tolls; and after discussion of same a motion by Commissioner Andrews was made that the tolls remain as at present.

Commissioner Wright offered an Amendment that a reduction of .05¢ per car be made,

passed.

The request of Sea Island Company as outlines above was refused.
