

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA  
HELD NOVEMBER 3RD., 1931.

Minutes last meeting read and approved, with the exception, that portion referring to Traffic Bureau Appropriation; and the Minutes were ordered amended, so that they would show that the appropriation would be discontinued October 31st., instead of Dec. 31st., 1931.

Mr. MacGregor, Juvenile Court Officer, appeared and discussed his work for the year, and asked that action taken at last meeting discontinuing the work be re-considered.

County Agent, Ragsdale, appeared and discussed his work for the year.

Major W.L. Hatwell, representing the Brunswick Riflemen Company appeared and asked that the County assist them in making payment on the Armory Building, which was due shortly, the amount being \$1,000. and he stated that it was his intention to ask the City to pay  $\frac{1}{2}$  of this amount.

Upon Motion, the sum of \$25.00 per Month was continued for the year 1932 for the Y.W. C.A.

Upon Motion, Jail fees for feeding Prisoners were reduced from .75¢ to .65¢.

Upon Motion, the Clerk was directed to advertise for paving 2.3 Miles of road on St. Simons, beginning at Twitty Park and continuing towards Frederica, to a point about 300 feet from the point where said road separates from one going to Lawrence; and also for the North "Y" of Twitty Park.

Upon Motion, the sum of \$200.00 was Appropriated towards assisting in carrying on the Night School for Illiterates.
