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Appropriation of \$100.00 for year 1932 made to Brunswick Library.

Upon Motion, the sum of \$1,700.00 was appropriated for Brunswick Board of Trade for a Period of 12 Months from February 1st.,1932.

Appropriation of \$1,100.00 was made for County Planning Board for a period of 12 Months from February 1st.,1932.

The following Resolution was offered and adopted:-

Whereas, it appears to this Board, that under the terms of a Contract for paving with the Langston Construction Company, that the County of Glynn will owe them a sum of approximately \$24,000.00; and that under the terms of said Contract, one half of same is to be paid in cash, and the other one-half by a Note or Notes, payable one year from date of execution at the rate of seven per centum per annum;

Therefore be it, and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such note or notes as above described.

The Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

Whereas, it appears to this Board that there is a casual deficiency in the Revenue of said County for the current year, and that it is necessary to supply said casual deficiency by a loan or loans to be repaid out of the taxes to be levied and assessed for the current year;

Therefore, be it and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman and Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$25,000.00 from such person or persons as may advance the same and on such terms and conditions and at such rate of interest as may be obtainable.

The following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

Whereas, it appears to this Board that the Department of Commerce, will, upon the completion of lighting, etc., of Site #5 on the Jacksonville-Richmond Airway, desire to release the same back to the County of Glynn.

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman, Malcolm B. McKinnon, be and he is hereby authorized to execute such lease or license as may be required by said, the Department of Commerce.
