Whereas, it appears to this Board that the State Highway Department of Georgia are relocating the road from Brunswick to Jesup and that in said re-location, Federal Aid Projects 80 and 64 are changed, and the County of Glynn is desirous of securing from said, the State Highway Board a Contract for the clearing and grubbing of said two projects as re-located.

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be, and they are hereby authorized to make application to said, the State Highway Board for a Contract for the clearing and grubbing of said two projects as re-located.
