THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED AND ADOPTED:-

W H E R E A S, Congress has passed an Act known as the "Emergency Relief Act," and that said Act applies to State and Political Subdivisions thereof and that said Act is being administered by the Reconstruction Finance Corporation. And,

Whereas, it appears to this Board that the unemployment situation in this County is not improving, possibly increasing and that some definite steps should be taken by this Board to try and relieve the condition and after due consideration of all it appears to us that such relief can only be obtained with the help of the Reconstruction Finance Corporation; and,

Whereas, it appears, that it is necessary to increase the facilities at our local Airport, and from estimates of cost, receipts, etc., prepared by our Engineer, it appears that such improvements would come within the law as set out in the above Act as "Self-Liquidating."

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman be, and he is hereby authorized to make application to said Reconstruction Finance Corporation for a sum sufficient to make the improvements, extensions and betterments at our local Airport and that he be given authority to execute such Contracts, Agreements or other writing as may be necessary and to pledge, (if necessary) State Highway Certificates of Indebtedness as security.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED AND ADOPTED:-

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman, be, and he is hereby authorized to make application to said Reconstruction Finance Corporation for a sum sufficient to make the improvements as set out above, and that he be given authority to execute such contracts, agreements, or other writings as may be necessary and to pledge (if necessary) State Highway Certificates of Indebtedness as security.
