

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA,

HELD SEPT., 6th., 1932.

Minutes last meeting read and approved.

B.F.Mann, and others, appeared, stating that they represented the South Georgia Singers' Convention and that they were meeting in Brunswick on the 17th. and 18th., inst., and requesting that the County contribute \$50.00 towards their entertainment, request granted.

H.G.Dowling, Kendrick Lamb and others, appeared before the Board requesting that some action be taken by them, towards enforcing the Motor Vehicle Act, and upon motion; The Chairman was directed to employ some-one for such purpose.

Wm. Clark, and others, appeared, requesting that County continue an appropriation of approximately \$400.00 for the continuance of the Home Economic work among the Colored People: Request Refused.

Judge Butts and R.S.Pyles, Sheriff, appeared in regard to a Cut in their Salaries.

George Cowart, Wsq., representing Bar Association, appeared, requesting that County employ a Stenographer for the purpose of taking down testimony in Criminal Cases, stating that the Bar Association had agreed to try all civil and criminal matters (When their Clients were agreeable) with 6 Jurors instead of 12.

And, in view of the above Stenographer was ordered employed at rate of \$15.00 per day for taking down (only) evidence in criminal cases; and this arrangement to last only so long, as Lawyers adhered to above.

The Following Resolution by Commissioner T.J.Wright was Offered and Adopted:-

Be it, and it is hereby resolved by the Commissioners of Roads & Revenue, of Glynn County, Georgia, in regular meeting assembled, that there be and is hereby levied and assessed for the year 1932 on all real and personal property in said County subject to taxation, to provide the necessary revenue for the requirements of the County, the following taxes for the following purposes:-

Also a Local School Tax to be levied on all property outside of the Corporate Limits of the City of Brunswick, therein, of .005 or \$5.00 on the \$1,000. being the rate fixed and certified to this Board by the Board of Education of Glynn County.

Be it further resolved that all such taxes be collected by the Tax Collector of said County, or his successors in Office, in the manner prescribed by law.
