REGULAR ADJOURNED MEETING HELD JANUARY 5TH., 1933.

Upon motion, Quit Claim Deed was ordered executed conveying to Atlantic Refining Co., all Streets, Lanes or Alleys, within the boundaries of their present enclosure; such Streets, Lanes or Alleys being shown on a blue Pring attached to Deed this day, presented for execution.

The following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board that there is a casual deficiency in the revenue of Glynn County for the Current Year and it is necessary to supply said casual deficiency by a loan or loans to be repaid our of the taxes to be levied and collected for the current year:

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved, that the Chairman and Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, from such person or persons as may advance the same, and on such terms and conditions and at such rate of interest as may be obtainable.

The following Resolution was Offered and adopted:-

WHEREAS, the County of Glynn is the owner of the Northern one-hald of Maritime Sub-

division Lot #29, in the City of Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia, which property is acquired at tax sale by deed from R.S.Pyles, as Sheriff of Glynn County, Georgia, dated June 6, 1932, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Glynn County, Georgia, in Deed Book 3-P, page 125, and which property was sold as the property of A.C. Stebbins, under a tax execution issued against the said Stebbins by W.L.Harwell, Tax Collector for Glynn County, Georgia, for 1921 State of Georgia, and County of Glynn taxes; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Glynn also is the owner of the Southern on-hald of the same lot which property it acquired at tax sale by deed from R.S.Pyles, as Sheriff as aforesaid, dated July 3, 1923, and recorded in the aforesaid Clerk's Office in Deed Book 3-Q, Page 390, and which property was sold as the property of the said A.C.Stebbins under a tax execution issued against the said Stebbins by W.L.Harwell, Tax Collector as aforesaid, for 1922 State of Georgia and County of Glynn taxes; and,

WHEREAS, Mrs. Stella T.Morton and F.J.Torras have offered to purchase all of said lot #29 in said Maritime Subdivision, from said County of Glynn at and for a total purchase price of \$47.08, which represents the amount of tax money and costs to said State of Georgia and County of Glynn upon said property under the two aforesaid tax deeds and executions, exclusive of interest, and which sum within the opinion of the County Commissioners of said County of Glynn represents the fair purchase price of said property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the aforesaid offer of Mrs. Stella T. Morton and F.J.Torras to purchase from said County of Glynn said lot #29 in the Maritime Subdivision of the City of Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia, at and for a purchase price of \$47.08, be and the same is hereby accepted and a proper deed of conveyance be made to them by said County of Glynn conveying said lot.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that E. L. Stephens and W.L.Harwell, two citizens of said County of Glynn, be and they are appointed as Commissioners for the purpose of executing and delivering to the said Mrs. Stella T.Morton and F.J.Torras said deed of conveyance, and as such Commissioners they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver under its corporate seal to the said Mrs. Stella T.Morton and F.J.Torras a good and sufficient deed without warranty on behalf of said County of Glynn conveying to them the said described property upon payment of the agreed purchase price.
