Minutes last meeting read and approved.

Appropriation of \$100.00 for year 1933 was made to Brunswick Library.

Request from A.E.Foote to use small pavilion on Neptune Park was refused.

Messrs. Dowling, Lamb and O'Quinn representing Association of Railway Employees
appeared before the Board.

Bills for the Month of January were approved and ordered paid.

The Following Resolution was Passed:-

It appearing that certain legislation has been introduced in the General Assembly of
this State for the regulation of motor vehicles on the highways of the State of Georgia,
and,

Whereas, it is an undisputed fact that if legislation is not passed which will give
the railroads of this State fair competition with motor vehicles, dire results will follow,
and,

Whereas, we are advised that the railroads pay into the treasury of the City of
Brunswick and County of Glynn the sum of \$97,408.82 per year and the motor vehicles pay
into the treasury of said City and County only \$152.05, and

Schools in all probability will be closed for lack of funds,

Whereas, in addition to taxes paid by said railroads, they have suffered heavy losses of revenue by unregulated motor competition, throughout the State of Georgia, and

Whereas, we are advised that in Glynn County, alone, they have reduced payrolls approximately \$75,000 per annum affecting employees and the Community financially,

It is therefore resolved, that our Senator and Representative be requested to support such legislation, as may in their opinion, be fair and give the relief to the railroads, as they evidently so urgently need.
