The Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

Whereas, The Georgia State College for Men at Tifton, Georgia, is the only four year
Senior College for men in South Georgia, and,

of the small expense in comparison to other colleges of the State are able to attend this college that would not be able to attend any other college, and,

Whereas, it is apparent from newspaper reports that the Board of Regents of the State of Georgia contemplates changing this College into a two years terminal agricultural School, and,

Whereas, it is the consensus of opinion of this Board that this College should be continued as a four years senior College:

That we now endorse this College and the work that is being done at said College and respectfully request said Board of Regents to make no change in so far as the State College for Men is concerned.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Committee appointed to present the merit of this College to the Board of Regents of Georgia with our request that no change be made in this institution.

The Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board that there is a casual deficiency in the revenue of said County of Glynn for the current year, and that it is necessary to supple said casual defificiency by a loan or loans to be paid out of the taxes to be levied and collected for the current year;; therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved that the Chairman and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars from such person or persons as may advance the same and on such terms and at such terms and at such rate of interest as may be obtainable.

The Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

Mr. M.N.Hunter offered the following resolution which was duly seconded by Mr.W.C. Little and approved by a majority of all members present:-

1. Be it resolved by the Commissioners Roads & Revenue of Glynn County, that Mr. Malcolm B. McKinnon is hereby authorized to make necessary application in the name of County of Glynn to the Governor of Georgis for an allotment of funds under Subsection (c) or Section 1, of the Emergency Relief and Construction Act of 1932 for Glynn County, Georgia, and that the said Mr. Malcolm B. McKinnon be and he is hereby authorized, designated and empowered to sign for and in behalf of said County of Glynn its obligation or obligations as hereinafter set forth in an amount or amounts totaling not more than(\$7,306.00) Seven Thousand Three Hundred Six & No/100--- Dollars.

2. Be it further resolved that Mr. A.O.Townsend is hereby designated to receive and act as the Disbursing Officer of all relief monies hereafter received by Glynn County under authority of Subsection (c) of the Section 1 of the Emergency Relief and Construction Act of 1932 of the Federal Congress. Said Disbursing Officer to give such security bond as may be required by the Governor of Georgia or his duly commissioned representatives.

3. Be it further resolved that the Glynn County Relief Committee is hereby designated as the official relief Organization of Glynn County and,

4. Be it further resolved that the Disbursing Officer hereinbefore designated and the official relief organization hereinbefore designated be and they are severally and jointly authorized, empowered and required to make accountings of any and all relief funds received by the said Disbursing Officer as may be from time to time required by

the Governor of Georgia and his duly authorized representatives, and also by the Reconstruction Finance Corporation of the Federal Government. Said accountings to include social statistics as well as clerical accounting.

5. Be it further resolved that the obligation or obligations referred to in paragraph 1 of this Resolution shall be in substantially the form of the County Obligation attached.
