The sum of \$100.00 was appropriated towards the expense of sending an exhibit to Century of Progress Exposition at Chicago.

Permission was granted to Southern Bell Tel. & Tel. Co., to erect a line of poles from a point on Ocean Road close residence of R.L.Pringle to Bruce Drive and thence North along Bruce Drive, provided poles are so set that they will not be a traffic hazard and also that they will re-set or remove when requested to do so by County Commissioners.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED AND ADOPTED:

Whereas, it has come to the attention of the Commissioners of Roads & Revenue of Glynn County, Georgia, that the United States Government purposes to establish Thirty-Five (35) State Forest Camps within this State and Whereas, Glynn County has a vast acreage of cut-over timber land and the Federal Government owns the land in this County known as Naval Reservation located on what is known as Blythe Islane. NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that this Commission wishes to go on record as respectfully urging that the Administrators of this Project allocate one of these Camps to be located within the bounds of Glynn County.
