The Following Resolution by Commissioner A.L. Church was Offered and Adopted:-

Be it, and it is hereby resolved by the Commissioners of Roads & Revenue of Glynn County, Georgia, in regular meeting assembled, that there be and is hereby levied and assessed for the year 1933 on all Real and Personal Property in said County subject to taxation, to provide the necessary revenue for the requirements of the County, the following taxes for the following purposes:-

1. To pay interest on bonded indebtedness,	.003330
2. To pay legal indebtedness due or to become due,	.003000
3. To pay any other lawful charges against the County,	.000225
4. To pay Sheriff's and other Officers their fees,	.000452
5. To pay Coroner,	.000050
6. To pay expenses of the County for Bailiff's non resident witnesses in criminal cases, fuel, servant hire, stationery and other like expenses,	.000100
7. To pay Jurors,	.000550
8. To support the Poor,	.000500
9. For Educational Purposes under the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly for Glynn County, approved October 15th., 1885 and the Election thereunder,	.000375

And, also a Local School Tax to be levied on all property outside of the Corporate Limits of the City of Brunswick, therein of .005 or \$5.00 on the \$1,000. being the rate fixed and certified to this Board by the Board of Education of Glynn County.

Be it further resolved that all such taxes be collected by the Tax Collector of said County, or his successors in Office in the manner prescribed by law.

The Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board, that the present emergency landing field on St. Simons Island is inadequate, that the demand for an Airport is very apparent, that it is not possible for Glynn County, Georgia to finance the construction of same without held, and,

It appearing to this Board that the construction of same is in futherance of a general scheme of planning in which the City of Brunswick and the County of Glynn have, in the last few years spent approximately \$1,000,000.00 to make their Island Resorts among the most popular on the South Atlantic Coast for both Summer and Winter Tourists:

And, it further appearing that the unemployment situation in Glynn County is critical, and possibly increasing and that the building of said Airport would furnish employment to

great many people over a period of approximately six months, thereby greatly relieving conditions, especially through the trying Winter Months; and,

It further appearing that the building of said Airport would not increase the tax burden on our people;

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved, that the Chairman make Application to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for a sum sufficient to build said Airport, and on such terms and conditions as he may see fit or may be required, offering to deposit such security as may be requested.

The Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

WHEREAS, it is apparent to this Board that the building of a Boat Garage for both Wet and Dry Storage on St. Simons Island is very necessary, that there are now approximately 26 Boats awaiting storage, that several yachts have had to leave in the last few weeks for lack of storage, and that it is not possible for Glynn County, Georgia to build same without help; and,

It appearing to this Board that the construction of same would be in furtherance of a general scheme of planning in which the City of Brunswick and County of Glynn have spent in the last few years approximately \$1,000,000.00 to make their Island Resorts among the most popular on the South Atlantic Coast for both Summer and Winter Tourists; And,

It further appearing that the unemployment situation in Glynn County is critical, and possibly increasing and that the building of said Boat Garage would furnish employment to a great many people over a considerable period of time, thereby greatly relieving conditions; and,

It further appearing that the building of said Boat Garage would not increase the tax burden on our people;

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved, that the Chairman make Application to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for a sum sufficient to build said Airport and on such terms and conditions as he may see fit or may be required, offering to deposit such security as may be requested.
