Minutes last meeting read and approved.

Messrs. Herbert Ringel, George Cowart and others appeared before the Board, stating that through the efforts of their Organization, the City of Brunswick had purchased land necessary for an Athletics Field, and that C.W.A. had agreed to furnish necessary labor both skilled and unskilled to do the necessary work and that approximately the sum of \$1,000.00 would be required to purchase necessary materials for same; and that unless the County could make such contribution that the Community would be without an Athletic Field this year, as the lease on the present location had expired, and after consideration of same and upon motion of Mr.W.C.Little, duly seconded, the Clerk was authorized to spend a sum not exceeding \$1,000.00 for the purchase of the necessary material for the construction of said Athletic Field.

Upon motion, Minnie Frasier of the 25th., District was placed on the Charity List at \$3.00 per Month.

Mrs.C.B.Conyers, and others appeared asking that County continue for a year, 1934 their usual appropriation of \$100.00 to Brunswick Library, upon motion, request was granted.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER PROPERTY WAS OFFERED AND ADOPTED:

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board that the County of Glynn is the Owner of Certain Real Property consisting of Streets, Lanes and Alleys and riparian rights on St. Simons Island and in that certain Subdivision laid out by St. Simons Island Investment Company, and that the same is of no value to the County of Glynn in the operation of its business, the same being within the boundaries or lying adjacent to property belonging to Sea Island Company; and it further appearing that said the Sea Island Company is the owner of certain property in the said Subdivision that lies within or bordering on property belonging to the County of Glynn and that same should be owned by said County; and

It further appearing that said, the County of Glynn and Sea Island Company have agreed on an exchange of the property mentioned.

Therefore, the Commissioners heretofore appointed, to-wit:- Messrs. W.L. Harwell, and E.L. Stephens are hereby requested to execute a Deed conveying to said Sea Island Company the following described property;

Tract #1. All of that certain lot, tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being on St. Simons Island, 25th., District, G.M., Glynn County, Georgia, and lying along the easterly side of Frederica River, immediately South of Frederica River Bridge, and described as bounded Northerly by the Southerly right of way of King's Way Public Road, extending in a Westerly direction to low water mark of said Frederica River; Easterly by the Westerly right of way line of Riverside Drive, as shown upon the map hereinafter referred to; Southerly by the Southerly property line of lands formerly belonging to St. Simons Island Investment Company, and Westerly by the present low water mark of Frederica River, the said Easterly boundary line being more particularly described and identified according to a map attached to a deed from Atlantic Life Insurance Company to St. Simons Island Investment Company, dated January 30, 1923, and recorded in the public records of Glynn County, Georgia, in Deed Book 3-Q, page 116.

Tract #2. All of those certain streets, roads and alley-ways in "Palm Harbor" subdivision, on St. Simons Island, as aforesaid, which lie South of the present Southerly boundary line of Hamilton Plantation, now owned by Eugene W. Lewis, which said streets, roads and alleyways so located South of the said Southern line of Hamilton Plantation, in said "Palm Harbor" subdivision, are clearly shown, named and delineated upon the map and plan of said "Palm Harbor" subdivision attached to and recorded with a certain quit claim deed from Atlantic Life Insurance Company to Saint Simons Island Investment Company, which deed is dated January 30, 1923, and which said map is recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of said County, in Deed Book 3-Q, page 116 et seq. it being understood however that reference is hereby had to present surveys of said Hamilton Plantation, and to the deed of conveyance conveying said Hamilton Plantation to said Eugene W. Lewis, for the purpose of locating its Southerly boundary line in said "Palm Harbor" subdivision.

Excepting, however, from the operation of this conveyance, all streets, roads, lanes or alley-ways which run or lead through the First Party's property in said "Palm Harbor" subdivision; and also the rights of way of all paved highways or public roads leading through said subdivision; and also all streets, roads, lanes, or alleyways leading through said subdivision that may extend into the property now owned by the estate of J.W. Bennet and the property now or formerly owned by W.F. Winecoff or wife.
