

REGULAR CALLED MEETING COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA,
HELD JULY 20TH., 1934.

Present: Hon. Malcolm B. McKinnon, Chairman, Commissioners Little, Royal, Paulk, and Ratcliffe.

Chairman McKinnon stated that the purpose of the meeting was to have a Joint-Meeting with the City Commissioners and that they were to hear from a delegation of representative Citizens in regard to a proposition to be submitted by George Cowart, Esq., that the State Highway Department take over and operate the Brunswick-St. Simons Highway.

Chairman McKinnon was asked to preside.

Mr. Cowart presented the proposition for the taking over of the Highway by the State Highway Board, and a general discussion of same followed, all those speaking favored the proposition and a Motion was made that the City and County Commissioners meeting in Joint-Session and act on the same in such manner as they saw fit.

The City and County Commissioners then adjourned to the Grand Jury Room and after discussion agreed that the Mayor and Chairman should write to George Cowart, Esq., stating that they were agreeable to the proposition and were willing that the State Highway Board take over the Highway on the terms and conditions as mentioned by him.
