

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA,  
HELD OCTOBER 2ND., 1934.

Present:- Hon. Malcolm B. McKinnon, Chairman, Commissioners, Little, Royal, Paulk, and Ratcliffe.

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Minutes last meeting read and approved.

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Bills approved.

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Reports from following received and ordered filed:-

Clerk St. Simons Highway,  
Clerk, City Court,  
County Supt.,  
County Police.

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Committee composed of Messrs. Shelander, Lewis, Rheu, Cowart, Zelmenovitz and Others representing the Brunswick Golf Club, appeared, stating that they had agreed on property about six miles North of Brunswick on the Coastal Highway known as "Oglethorpe Farms" as a suitable location for a Golf Course and that F.E.R.A. had agreed to furnish labor necessary for the work and that the cost of same would be approximately as follows:-

Cost of land (to be furnished by City and County)	\$11,080.00
Cost of Well, fencing and other incidentals, (to be furnished by City and County).	12,200.00
Labor cost to be furnished by F.E.R.A.	<u>20,880.00</u>
Making a Total of	\$44,160.00

And requested that County make application to F.E.R.A. for the labor necessary for same, and after considering same.

The Chairman was directed to make such application provided, same was agreeable to the City Commissioners.

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Upon Motion the sum of \$50.00 was ordered paid to George Deaver, Convict Guard, for the month of October, he, having been absent from work on account of sickness.

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Upon Motion, the Chief of County Police was directed to employ a Policeman for St. Simons Island for the Winter Months.

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The following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board that by Deed from Saint Simons Island Investment Company to the County of Glynn dated May 14, 1923, recorded in Book 3-Q, certain Rights-of-Way for Roads were conveyed to said County.

AND WHEREAS, it appears that Gascoigne Circle, one of said Streets conveyed by said Deed has never been opened for use by said County and has no value to them as a public Way.

AND, it further appears that Mrs. Grace S. Winecoff is the Owner of Lot #1, in a Subdivision laid out by said Saint Simons Island Investment Company.

AND, it further appears that said Gascoigne Circle runs through the said Lot #1.

THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby resolved that, Messrs. E.L. Stephens and W.L. Harwell, Commissioners appointed by Glynn County for the purposes of conveying Real Estate, be requested to execute a Quit-Claim Deed to said, Mrs. Grace S. Winecoff to all that part of Gascoigne Circle as lies within the said Lot #1 as mentioned above.
