Following Resolution was offered and adopted:-

Whereas, the tides for several years have caused serious erosions of the shore lines of the beach on Saint Simons Island, Glynn County, Georgia, which have grown worse within the past three years - the high tides now making encroachments upon the homesites of persons whose property fronts on the beach in the vicinity of the light house property of the United States, the encroachments having already washed away a considerable portion of the latter property fronting on said beach, all of which will be further encroached upon unless proper steps are taken by the Government to correct such erosions by means of jetties, which can be constructed without a great outlay of money; and

Whereas, it is the desire of this Body and the people interested in the preservation of this beautiful seaside resort to have corrected the troubles hereinabove mentioned and referred to.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by this body, and it is resolved by the authority of the same, that we do hereby approve the construction of jetties mentioned in the preamble, to the end that the erosions, likewise referred to, may be stopped by means thereof,

that we respectfully request the Unites States Government to take cognizance of this situation and, through the department having such matters in charge, enter upon the setting up of jetties or other means having for their object the prevention of any further erosions, and, as well, to correct the great damage already done, which we are persuaded can be accomplished by such methods.

Following Resolution was Offered and Adopted:-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, OF GLYNN COUNTY GEORGIA, TO FILE AN APPLICAION TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THROUGH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR A GRANT TO AID IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF BOAT GARAGE AND YACHT BASIN AT ST.SIMONS ISLAND, GA., AND DESIGNATING FRANCES L.ABREU, TO FURNISH SUCH INFORMATION AS THE GOVERNMENT MAY REQUEST.

Be it resolved by the Commissioners of Roads & Revenue of Glynn County,Georgia:

Section 1. That Malcolm B.McKinnon be, and he is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of Commissioners of Roads & Revenue of Glynn County,Georgia, to the Unites States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of Boat Garage and Yacht Basin at St.Simons Island, Ga.

Section 2. That Frances L.Abreu, be hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Unites States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed.

The Following Resolution by Commissioner R.L.Ratcliffe was offered and adopted:

Be it, and it is hereby resolved by the Commissioners of Roads and Revenue of Glynn County, Georgia in regular meeting assembled, that there be and is hereby levied and assessed for the year 1935 on all Real and Personal Property in said County subject to taxation, to provide the necessary revenue for the requirements of the County, the following taxes for the following purposes:-

- 1. To pay interest on bonded indebtedness, .002500
 - 2. To pay legal indebtedness due or to become due, .003000
 - 3. To pay any other lawful charges against the County, .000225
 - 4. To pay Sheriff's and other Officers their fees, .000450
 - 5. To pay Coroner, .000050
 - 6. To pay expenses of the County for Bailiff's non resident witnesses in Criminal Cases, fuel, servant hire, stationery and other like expenses, .000100
 - 7. To pay Jurors, .000550
 - 8. To support the Poor, .001000
 - 9. For Educational purposes under the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly for Glynn County approved October 15,1985 and the Election thereunder, .000375
 - 10. For Public Roads, .002850
 - 11. To pay County Police, .000960
 - 12. To provide expenses for County Board of Health, .001260
 - 13. For repairs for Court House and Jail, .001920
 - 14 ..To pay Glynn County's part of bonded indebtedness of the Coastal Highway District of Georgia, .000760
- A TOTAL OF016000

Or \$16.00 on the \$1,000.00.

And also a local School Tax to be levied on all property outside of the Corporate Limites of the City of Brunswick, therein, of .005 or \$5.00 on the \$1,000.00, being the rate fixed and certified to this Board by the Board of Education of Glynn County.

Be it further esolved that all such taxes be collected by the Tax Collector of said County, or his successoris in office in the manner prescribed by law.
