

REGULAR ADJOURNED MEETING HELD JANUARY 15TH., 1936 (ADJOURNED OVER FROM JANY.7TH., 1936), OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF ROADS & REVENUE, GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA.

Present: Malcolm B. McKinnon, Chairman, W.C. Little, A.L. Church, V.H. Royal, J.B.D. Paulk, R.L. Ratcliffe and H.D. Taylor.

The Chairman stated that the purpose of the meeting was to receive Bids for the construction of Auditorium-Pier, St. Simons Island, Ga.

Bids from the following were received:-

Artley & Company,	Savannah, Ga.,	Base Bid of \$65,800.00
W.H. Greenfield,	Brunswick, Ga.,	Base Bid of \$68,330.70

After consideration of above bids, and upon motion of Commissioner Royal seconded by Commissioner Little, the base bid of Artley & Company for \$65,800.00 was accepted subject to the approval of P.W.A. and the Chairman and Clerk were authorized to execute contract and also any future contracts or agreements between the County and the Contractor or the County and P.W.A.

The Vote being unanimous for same.

Upon Motion of Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, it was ordered that Building be made Fireproof, if same were possible with funds available.

Upon Motion of Commissioner Little, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, it was ordered that following amounts included in the original plans be transferred to Construction Account of Auditorium-Pier;-

"\$15,000.00 Swimming Pool,
1,000.00 Artesian Well,
2,000.00 Pool Equipment,
2,000.00 Bowling Alley Equipment."
