Also, asking that an Officer be appointed in Glynn Haven Estates. Upon motion the Chief of County Police was authorized to employ an Officer without Salary.

J.J. Lissner and Others appeared before Board asking that County contribute \$300.00 towards defraying expenses of Boat Races on St. Simons on July 4th., 1936. Upon motion \$150.00 was appropriated.

Mumford Tyson, Esq., appeared asking that County cooperate in Screw-Worm Control by setting aside a sum to be used in buying material for above purpose not exceeding \$100.00 This material be furnished Stock Owners at cost. Upon motion request was granted.

W.N. Gramling, appeared, asking that County open up 6th. St., through Waller proper-

ty on St.Simons Island. A Committee composed of Malcolm B.McKinnon and W.C.Little were appointed with power to act.

Henry Farr Esq., appeared, representing Roy B.Setzer demanding payment of past due salary as Juvenile Court Officer. Upon motion request was refused.

Mr.Kenneth Berrie and Others appeared requesting an appropriation for Postal Employees Convention to be held on July 18th., of \$75.00. Upon motion request was granted.

Upon motion Clerk and Chairman were authorized to sell Lots in Blocks "E" & "F" St.Simons Park Subdivision to any prospective Home Builders for \$200.00 each.

The Chairman and Clerk were authorized to purchase Tractor, Plow and Truck for Brunswick Peninsula T.P.O. not exceeding \$5,000.00 on best terms possible.

They to furnish, equipt and operate without any cost to County. This Lease to have an option for an additional five (5) years at an annual rental to be agreed upon.
