Hurricane Matthew (Update 2)

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- Glynn County would like to advise the public of the potential threats that are anticipated with Hurricane Matthew. While there has been no change in the track of the storm, the potential for heavy rain, flooding in low lying areas, and damaging winds as a result of Hurricane Matthew is increasing for Glynn County, and residents should prepare accordingly. Current weather conditions are being caused by a nor'easter off the coast that will bring soaking rains prior impacts felt by Hurricane Matthew.

As we continue to monitor the track of the storm, we would advise Glynn County residents to make the appropriate preparations. Although there are **no evacuations** in place for Glynn County at this time, residents should review their family emergency plans and register your cell phone and/or email addresses in the CodeRED system in order to receive emergency alerts when you are away from home. Residents should closely monitor the future progress of the storm. The storm could pose a threat to the region within 72 hours.
