The above delegation also discussed advertising the advantages of Brunswick and St.Simons as Tourist Resorts and upon motion the sum of \$250.00 was appropriated.

Upon motion, 1/6 cost of R/W in Bacon County was ordered paid on Route from Sycamore, via Alma, Patterson, Hortense, Thalman and Old Sterling into Brunswick; It being made to appear that if this R/W is secured the State Highway Board will take the same over as a part of their System.
