Whereas, it appears to this Board that the United States Government desires to lease the property hereinafter described at Glynn County Airport on St. Simons Island, Georgia, for the time and purposes hereinafter stated;

Therefore, be it, and it is hereby resolved, that the Chairman, be, and he

is hereby authorized to lease to said, The United States Government a room approximately 15'7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " X 11'2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " located in the southeast corner of the new administration building on Glynn County Airport, St.Simons Island, Glynn County, Georgia, to be used for the establishment and maintenance of a Weather Reporting and Teletypewriter Station for a term beginning October 16th.,1937 to June 30th.,1938 at and for an annual rental of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year, with the privilege of renewal from year to year, at the same rental provided, that no renewal shall extend beyond June 30th.,1945.

Upon motion, the Clerk was directed to submit to the City of Brunswick the following changes in Tolls on St.Simons Highway to become effective, if approved by them, on January 1st.,1938.
