Upon motion of R.L.Ratcliffe, seconded by C.V.Abbott, R.A.Gould, Esq., was
appointed Chairman.

Upon motion C.V.Abbott was appointed a member of the Board of Directors of the
Board of Trade.

Reports from following were received and ordered filed:-

County Superintendent of Roads,

Upon motion the sum of \$50.00 was appropriated to pay Membership Dues to
County Commissioners Association.

Upon motion the Clerk was authorized to have Plans for rebuilding and paving
road to Frederica completed as early as possible.

Upon motion the following increase in salaries were approved:-

County Engineer,	\$25.00 per Month.
Clerk in County Engineer's Office,	2.50 per Week.
Janitor,	2.00 per Week.

The following Resolution was offered and adopted:-

W H E R E A S the General Assembly of the State of Georgia amended the Traylor-Neill Bill on December 14th., 1937 to include a road from a point twelve (12) miles north of Brunswick on State Route 25, the Coastal Highway, near Broadfield, to a point on State Route 27, near Sterling, a distance of seven (7) miles; and from a point on State Route 32, near Anguilla, to a point on State Route No.50, near Brookman, a distance of seven (7) miles; and

W H E R E A S this Road, when improved, will shorten the distance to traffic between State Routes 50, 27 and 25, relieve congestion on the Coastal Highway through Brunswick and serve as a detour from the Coastal Highway, particularly in connection with any reconstruction work on the Turtle River Bridge,

T H E R E F O R E, B E I T R E S O L V E D by the Commissioners of Roads and Revenue of Glynn County, Georgia in lawful meeting assembled, that the State Highway Board be and is hereby earnestly requested to formally designate said road as a part of the State Aid System as provided by law.
