

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROAD AND REVENUE WAS HELD TUESDAY  
FEBRUARY 7TH., 1939.

Minutes last meeting read and approved.

Mr. R.E.Sherman and J.E.Lambright appeared before Commission asking that the monthly donation to the Public Library be increased.

Upon motion by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe it was ordered that the sum of \$30.00 per month be allocated, for 1939.

Mr.J.Hunter Hopkins as Mayor and City Commissioner H.P.McDonald appeared, asking that a Committee be appointed to confer with a like Committee from the City Commissioners upon the matter of consolidating certain Department of the City and County.

Upon motion, this matter was referred to Chairman Gould for further handling as to Jail and Police Departments.

Mr.J.E.Lambright appeared before the Commission with an Advertising Project. Upon motion, this was referred to the Chairman to handle, with the proviso that if, in his judgement we would enter into this to the extent of one-half page provided the City took a half-page.

On Motion by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk that a Committee be appointed to confer with the City as to the purchase of 10 Mattresses for the City Hospital, with authorization to purchase 5 Mattresses for the account of the County if the City would purchase a like amount. Mr. Owens was appointed as a Committee of One to attend to this matter.

Mrs. Estelle B.Sawtelle appeared before the Commission asking that certain roads on St.Simons in the vicinity of the Pink Chapel be opened up. This matter was referred to County Engineer Friedman for handling.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Owens that bill in favor of Southern Bell Telephone & Telegraph Co., Tel.#224, that was questioned, be paid. Amount of same \$76.55.

Committee from the Board of Trade of St.Simons Island appeared before the Commission asking that they be allowed to install an Information Office in the forks of the road near Frederica Bridge.

On motion this matter was referred to the County Engineer, Friedman, with power to act.

Alfred Nobles, Colored, appeared asking that a certain road in the vicinity of Pennick be worked, this was also referred to Mr. Friedman to investigate and remedy if possible.

Mrs. George Gowen appeared in support of a communication from the Cassina Garden Club of St.Simons asking that a clean-up Campaign be inaugurated and asking for other betterments.

The Following Resolution was offered by Commissioner Abbott and adopted:-

RESOLVED that in recognition of and obedience to the restraining Order issued by the Superior Court of Glynn County, Georgia, the hearings set before this body for this date against W.L.Harwell and Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York, the surety on his Bonds as Tax Commissioner and Tax Collector under the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly of 1933, are hereby continued until the 7th., day of March,1939.

There being a vacancy on the Planning Board, upon Motion, Mrs.Margaret D. Cate was re-elected .

Upon Motion by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk the sum of \$300.00 each was voted to C.L.Gowen and S.Hadley Brown for expenses in connection with Legislation in connection with Four Million Dollar Bond Issue for the Coastal Highway.
