Dr.J.W.Buggs and Dr.M.A.Cassells as Committee from Colored Park appeared before
the Commission asking the retention of Manager Gibbs, On motion, this matter was referred
to Commissioner Harley to act.

Mr.Geo.B.Cowart and A.A.Nathan appeared before Commission with Resolution from
Board of Trade of St. Simons Island. On motion Resolution was accepted and ordered filed.

Mr. Geo. W. Wannamaker, Superintendent of Public Schools appeared before Commission asking for funds to continue Schools until end of term. On motion by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, that a donation be made the Board of Education in the amount of \$1,294.46.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe that County Commissioners make a loan by discounting or Cashing the Warrants of the Board of Education in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00

Bonds to be recorded and filed in Commissioners Office.

County Engineer Friedman appeared before Commission in regard to the uses of the County Dock on St. Simons. On motion by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Royal, County Engineer was instructed to place suitable signs on the dock as to tying up Boats, etc.

The Action of Meeting of March 7th., in naming W. McD. Harley as Acting Clerk is hereby rescinded as of this date.

Communication received from D. T. Cowart, On motion by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk the following Resolution was offered and adopted:-

"Resolved that the Actions of the Chairman of this Commission in handling County affairs are approved by the entire Board and they are the actions of the entire Commission."
