GLYNN COUNTY, Ga. – Pamela Kay Thompson has been selected as the new Director of Community Development for Glynn County, Georgia. Ms. Thompson brings over 18 years of experience in local government. She is currently the Executive Director for the Athens Downtown Development Authority. Prior to that, she served for six years as Deputy County Administrator for Planning, Capital and Special Projects for the County of Prince George, VA. She has also served as Planning Director and Assistant County Administrator for Lee County, GA. Ms. Thompson has a bachelor's degree in Communications from Mercer University and a Master's in Public Administration from Georgia Southern University. She is an ICMA Credentialed Manager and is AICP Certified through the American Planning Association.
