## **Police and Citizens Together meeting scheduled**

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga. – The Glynn County Police Department will be hosting a “Police and Citizens Together” community meeting on Tuesday, January 17, 2017, from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Bible Baptist Church, 500 Harry Driggers Blvd., Brunswick. The goal of the meeting is to prevent crime in specific, targeted areas and improve police services. Meetings are being held in various locations throughout Glynn County over the course of the year. Residents and businesses are invited to meet the Chief and division managers as key points of contact, review police calls and crime calls in the area, and discuss the ABCs to crime prevention. Participants will also have the opportunity to ask questions during the one hour meeting.

The target area for this meeting will be the area north of Chapel Crossing Rd. to the McIntosh County line and east of I-95 to include Glynnco Pkwy., Harry Driggers Blvd., and neighborhoods adjacent to US-17. Information for the presentations will be prepared using the County’s new Spillman Public Safety System which will map police calls and areas where crime has occurred. This new system allows law enforcement to analyze calls and crime in order to better plan priorities, prevent crime, and provide timely responses to incidents.
