## Glynn County officials monitoring Hurricane Irma (Update 2)

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- Glynn County would like to advise the public of the potential threats that are anticipated with Hurricane Irma. While there have been minor changes in the track of the storm, the potential for heavy rain, flooding in low lying areas, and damaging winds as a result of Hurricane Irma is increasing for Glynn County, and residents should prepare accordingly. Current weather conditions are being caused by a nor'easter off the coast that will bring soaking rains prior to impacts felt by Hurricane Irma.

As we continue to monitor the track of the storm, we would advise Glynn County residents to make the appropriate preparations. Although there are **no evacuations** in place for Glynn County at this time, residents should review their family emergency plans and register your cell phone and/or email addresses in the CodeRED system in order to receive emergency alerts when you are away from home.
