Public Service Announcement: September 8, 2017

Need-A-Ride Drop Off Location Updates

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- The Glynn County Board of Commissioners would like to advise the public that based on the current forecast, Glynn County is still expecting to see impacts in our area. Although some weather projections have pushed the storm on a more westward path, Hurricane Irma has not made landfall and has the potential to be extremely unpredictable. Based on the information that we have at this time, Glynn County remains under a mandatory evacuation. Storm surge and high winds are anticipated as well as widespread power outages.

The Need a Ride program has exhausted their resources for Friday, September 8, 2017, and will not be making any more trips today. They will begin boarding passengers on Saturday, September 9, 2017, at 10 a.m. only at Lanier Plaza, located at 1919 Glynn Avenue, Brunswick, GA. Busses will leave when filled and no additional trips will be made through the Need a Ride program out of Glynn County for the duration of this evacuation.

Glynn County officials continue to monitor the storm and advise residents to prepare for deteriorating weather conditions. We will release another public service announcement before noon tomorrow, Saturday, September 9, 2017.
