Site Plan Requirements

4 sets of plans for Commercial pools. 3 sets of plans for Residential pools or electronic copy.

Plan sheets minimum size of 24" X 36", scaled at 1/8 or 1/4 inch

Clearly show the following on the Pool Plan:

- 1) Address, street frontage, lot line dimension, building setbacks and any easements and CMPA lines
- 2) All existing structures with dimensions from property lines
- 3) Pool size and depths with dimensions from property lines
- 4) Location and type of pool equipment with dimensions from property line and structures
- 5) Location of water source for filling/maintaining water level and label as private well or JWSC meter
- 6) If autofill is installed, show auto fill line with PVB (Pressure Vacuum Breaker) installed. (Watts 800M4FR or equivalent)
- 7) Pool drainage, overflow, and discharge areas
- 8) Add note: "No discharge of pool water into JWSC collection system"
- 9) Add note: "All hose bibs have a hose bib vacuum breaker"
- 10) For commercial pools: ADA access, ADA lift, ladders, steps, fence, and gates

Georgia has adopted the 2018 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code (ISPSA). All new Pools must meet all the requirements in this code including Pool Area Barriers.

OWNER AFFIDAVIT:

If you are the owner and intend to do the work or subcontract the work out, you must complete the following affidavit certifying that you are the owner of this parcel of land, that you have applied for this permit, and you are not subject to licensing as a contractor or subcontractor. Signing the affidavit, and in turn obtaining the permit in your name, names you are the owner, responsible for the work and compliance with applicable state and local codes.
