Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program  
to include Transportation Performance Management Targets

**WHEREAS**, federal regulations require that the Metropolitan Transportation Plans and Transportation Improvement Programs include Performance Management Targets for urbanized areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the amendment to the 2018-2021 TIP has been carried out in accordance with the provisions of Title 23 CFR Part 450, and in accordance with the procedures outlined in the Public Participation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Brunswick Area Transportation Study (BATS) in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, and the Georgia Department of Transportation has adopted PM2: Pavement and Bridge Condition on interstate and non-interstate NHS roads Performance Management Targets for use in the transportation process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Brunswick Area Transportation Study (BATS) in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, and the Georgia Department of Transportation has adopted PM3: Travel Time Reliability, Peak Hour Excessive Delays, and Freight Reliability on interstate and non-interstate NHS roads Performance Management Targets for use in the transportation process; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the BATS Policy Committee approves the amendment to the 2018 – 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to incorporate Performance Management Targets PM 2 and PM 3 as approved by the Georgia Department of Transportation.


