


the best evidence rule, *unless* you immediately notify opposing counsel and the undersigned judge upon receipt of copies of documentary evidence from the other party. Any party objecting to the authenticity of an exhibit or insisting on the best evidence rule may be held liable for costs incurred by the other party in connection with the attendance of witnesses solely for the purpose of authenticating the exhibit or producing the original thereof.
