1. Receive citizen comments regarding the proposed Glynn County FY20-21 budget.  
[REPORT EMAILED PUBLIC COMMENTS](#)

Tamara Munson, Interim Chief Financial Officer, presented a brief overview of the proposed FY21 budget. She stated that the focus of the FY21 is the Strategic Plan during this time of financial uncertainty. She explained that the goal of a governmental budget is to balance expenditures with revenues. She then outlined the County's source of revenues, the differences in the tax types that the County collects, and the major expenditure categories. Ms. Munson reported that the total expenditures come out to be approximately \$110 million and outlined the use of fund balance. She also compared the millage rates by district and reported that there was no change in those from the previous fiscal year. Ms. Munson stated that the bottom line was that market costs increased nationwide by 2.3% in 2019, however the Glynn County FY21 proposed budget only increased 0.34% due to a fiscally conservative budget approach.

This item was opened for public comment, yet no one addressed the Board, neither in person at the W. Harold Pate Building nor via email.

A motion was made by Commissioner O'Quinn and seconded by Commissioner Booker to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
