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Revetment (Johnson Rocks) Restoration

Glynn County Ga., As a part of the first phase of the restoration of the Johnson rocks revetment along the public areas of the St. Simons Island oceanfront, three parking areas in the Coast Guard Station parking lot farthest from the beach will be used to stockpile the new rock on Thursday, October 1, 2020. The project is intended to bring the current footprint of the revetment up to 8.5 feet above sea level. This phase was provided for in a \$2.5 million OneGeorgia Authority grant that must be used by April 2021.

Due to the short window of time between tourist season and the grant end date, the rocks will begin to be installed at street ends and Massengale Park as soon as possible. Work will be delayed in the Neptune Park section until after November 9, 2020 to accommodate the influx of visitors during Georgia/Florida weekend.

Other funding sources are being sought to raise the revetment along the other areas of the oceanfront, much of which fronts private property. For more information on the project and permitting, visit www.glynncounty.org/Revetment-Project.
