INVOCATION AND PLEDGE

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Consider rescinding adoption of the 2020 Millage Rates for Glynn County and Resolution #R-38-20 voted on at the August 20, 2020, Board of Commissioners Meeting. [REPORT](#)

Tamara Munson, Interim Chief Financial Officer, reported that the Department of Revenue regulations requires public hearings for millage rates to be held at least 5 (five) business days apart. County staff had followed state law when advertising the public hearings which does not specify how many days apart the hearings have to be held, and the public hearings were held only 4 (four) business days apart. Therefore, staff is requesting that the Board rescind adoption of the 2020 Millage Rates, hold another public hearing at this meeting to meet the Department of Revenue's requirement and then readopt the 2020 Millage Rates.

A motion was made by Commissioner Brunson and seconded by Commissioner Coleman to rescind adoption of the 2020 Millage Rates for Glynn County and Resolution #R-38-20 voted on at the August 20, 2020 Board of Commissioners Meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
