Discussion and consideration of voting on the following:

1. Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST 2021)

Commissioner Browning reported that with the upcoming year there will be a new Glynn County Board of Commissioners and the new board will have to look at the numbers to make any decisions regarding SPLOST 2021. He explained that the purpose of this meeting was to start the process and to fulfil the legal obligation to hold a meeting this month so the item

can be placed on the ballot. He also reported that the new Board may be interested in a five-year SPLOST. He encouraged Alan Ours, County Manager, and Regina McDuffy, City Manager, to work together to schedule a Joint Meeting in January as they will be more at liberty to hold a discussion about these things at that time. He then turned the meeting over to Mayor Harvey for discussion and questions.

The Commissioners held a discussion regarding the 3-year versus 5-year SPLOST, a March ballot versus a November ballot, and whether the SPLOST will include a tier one project. They reported that there were too many variables at this time to determine the numbers for SPLOST 2021.
